## Peter Serafinowicz, BLT pasta and a kombucha



NICK GRIMSHAW: Hello and welcome to Dish from Waitrose. I'm Nick Grimshaw

ANGELA HARTNETT: And I'm Angela Hartnett.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Is fantastic.

ANGELA HARTNETT: So much. So much.

NICK GRIMSHAW: So much stuff.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: You may have seen him in Shaun of the Dead.

**ANGELA HARTNETT: Mm.** 

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** You may have seen him in Guardians of the Galaxy. Currently in Amandaland.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yes.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** He's playing an amazing character in Amandaland, which we love.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** He did, yeah. He brings it to life, he's brilliant.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Johannes. And he's also here to talk about his brand new TV show that he's done for Netflix, big game show-

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: -called Million Dollar Secret.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** He's a man of many, many talents.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Many talents.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Many.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Great at an impression.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** And also did one man shows as well.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Oh yeah, yeah, yeah. And you know, he's made like music videos as well? He made-

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Really?

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** -music videos for Hot Chip.

**ANGELA HARTNETT: Ohhh-**

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

**ANGELA HARTNETT: -okay.** 

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

ANGELA HARTNETT: And he does loads of voiceovers as well, he's-

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** He does.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** -you know, Star Wars and stuff, he's been incredible.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Uh-huh. Yeah.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Very busy man.

NICK GRIMSHAW: He's a man who makes you feel...

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Much like yourself.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Lazy.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** [laughs]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Is Peter Serafinowicz. Before we get Peter in, we have a question from a listener called Niamh, hi Niamh. Niamh says, 'Hi guys, listen religiously. My friends and I have regular themed dinner parties and rotate who is responsible for each course. All very competitive. The next dinner party theme is 'Italy', and I have the starter to make. What are a couple of great Italian starters that I could make to redeem myself after the pretty average dessert that I made at a last dinner party?' First of all, I love that idea.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** I don't like the competitive edge, because I would feel the pressure.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** How do they judge it, each other, you know? That's quite, you know, it's like...

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Ooh, to judge it, ooh...

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Seven. Six.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** But I like the idea of doing a theme and everyone does a thing.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah. Bring something along, yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Pot wonder.

NICK GRIMSHAW: So the theme 'Italy', you are Angela Hartnett.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Of Murano fame.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: What is a good Italian starter that could be wow?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** God, there's so many. I mean, if you really wanted to show off you would do a lovely pasta dish, or a risotto dish.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** But if you're not confident in cooking, that might be a bit much for you.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Also I don't know about travelling with pasta.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Is she not allowed to do a little bit of prep when she gets there?

NICK GRIMSHAW: She could do prep when she gets there, I guess, yeah.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah, I, gets there. I mean, listen, we've just had Easter, it's asparagus season, it's a perfect thing to do something like that. If you like mozzarella, you should buy the more fancy burrata.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Which I know you like.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Which has got this lovely creamy centre. Take your asparagus, lightly blanch them, finish them on the grill so it has that little smoky flavour to them, and then serve them with your burrata on top, lovely little olive oil and some crushed up roasted hazelnuts on top of that.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Mmm.** 

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** I think that would work.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** That'd be a nice one.

NICK GRIMSHAW: And I also think when presenting it, say-

ANGELA HARTNETT: 'Angela Hartnett.'

[laughter]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** 'So, Angela Hartnett actually suggested I make this.' Cause then you're like, 'Ohh!'

ANGELA HARTNETT: 'Ohh!'

NICK GRIMSHAW: I feel like you could serve sawdust and say-

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** [laughs]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** 'I actually got this recipe personally from Angela Hartnett.'

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** 'From Angela Hartnett.' Yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** And they'd be like, 'Mmm, the sawdust, it's, it's nice and dry.'

ANGELA HARTNETT: Mm. Yeah, yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah, it's nice.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Lovely, yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Um, so good luck, Niamh.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah, good luck.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Let us know how it goes on, please.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: If you want to email us at any time, you can, dish@waitrose.co.uk.

ANGELA HARTNETT: UK.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Hey, shall we get Peter in?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yes. Looking forward to chatting to him.

[theme music]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Please can we make some noise for actor, comedian, and our biggest fan...

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** [laughs]

NICK GRIMSHAW: Peter Serafinowicz.

[applause]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Hi!** 

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah!** 

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Thank you. Thank you.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Hi, Peter.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Hi.** 

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Hi Peter.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Hi.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Welcome to Dish.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Thank you. This is so weird to be in this show.

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** It's like...

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Good weird?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, no, in a great way.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Okay, good, okay.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** In a great way.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Yes.** 

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah. Just to let you know, I've eaten.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Great, Good start.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Great. Good start.

[laughter]

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Should we get a taxi now?

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Not hungry at all.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** [laughs]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Um...** 

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** You know it's the food podcast?

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Yeah, no, no, no, no, no, l'm-

NICK GRIMSHAW: Well, what did you eat? What did you eat?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Well, I did eat breakfast. I had some sultana bran and apple juice.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Very healthy.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mmm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, thanks.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Nice.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** But I mean, I have apple juice instead of the milk.

[crew laugh]

**ANGELA HARTNETT: Oh!** 

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Right...

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, what's your problem?

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Right, right... So you started your day with that?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, I did, yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: And then have you had any lunch, or is this it?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** No, this is it.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Oh that's all right.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Oh, all right, well...

NICK GRIMSHAW: You'll be all right, you'll be okay.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, good, good.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Good.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** You'll be okay. So I introduced you as our biggest fan, but I don't know if that is hyperbole.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: But you do consume Dish?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I do, yeah.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I mean, I've watched the recent ones.

NICK GRIMSHAW: But did you watch them 'cause you were coming on?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I, I did-

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** [laughs]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, yeah, yeah, yeah

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** -no, no, no, no, no. Well, I started watching them, and lots of people listen to the show.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** But like, because I started with the visual one, I think it would be hard for me to go back to...

NICK GRIMSHAW: I've never watched it. Have you?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** I've listened- no.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** You've never watched it?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** No.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: No.** 

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Really?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** You watched the clips, haven't we?

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah, watched the clips.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** I'm, I've never watched a whole episode.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: No.** 

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Oh, okay.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** But do you watch everything you're in?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** No.

[crew laugh]

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Exactly.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** No, no, no, no, no, no.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** You know.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I mean, I used to, when I first started out, but like, ugh, God, no. No.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** [laughs]

NICK GRIMSHAW: No.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** You know, have you seen some of this stuff I'm

in?

[laughter]

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Amazing. I love Amandaland.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** [laughs]

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Come on.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Oh, well Amandaland, that's great.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Oh yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I'm brilliant in it.

[laughter]

NICK GRIMSHAW: You are. You really are.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** You are.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** [in Joanna Lumley voice] And I know Joanna was on.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** [in Joanna Lumley voice] I watched her and she called me actually the day after and she said, 'Darling, I, I feel terrible. I think I've got food poisoning.'

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** But she, isn't she just amazing?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** She's amazing.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** She's unreal. I felt really nervous, interviewing her. Did you?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah. She's so cool. She wanted to have a good time-

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** -and she relaxes you.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Thought she was brilliant.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Yeah, I didn't feel relaxed, I felt really nervous to be ho...

[laughter]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** There's certain people I think that when you sit down with them, you have a sort of out of body experience-

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Oh yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** -because they look so much like the person that they are, like I interviewed Elton John, and he looked so like Elton John.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, he does, doesn't he? He does.

NICK GRIMSHAW: I couldn't handle it because it- we- be-

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** But who did you expect him to look like?

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Well, no, no, but I mean like, it'd be like interviewing Madonna-

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: -in a cone bra with a head mic on, like-

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah, yeah, yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Right, okay...

[laughter]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Like Elton John with the glasses, do you know what I mean?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah, yeah, yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** It's like, you could probably interview Madonna and you're like it's a lady and it's Madonna.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Whereas Elton John and Joanna Lumley. It's the caricature of what you think they-

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah, yeah, sure, sure.

NICK GRIMSHAW: -are if you know what I mean.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah...

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Like Jonna Lumley is like, holding spices in like a nice kaftan.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** [laughs]

NICK GRIMSHAW: Being like, [in Joanna Lumley voice] 'Well, Nick...'.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** [laughs]

NICK GRIMSHAW: It was like...

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** [in Joanna Lumley voice] I mean, she's so, so beautiful.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** [laughs]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I mean-

NICK GRIMSHAW: So beautiful.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** She's beautiful-

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** -like from the inside out-

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yes, definitely.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** -and just radiates it, you know.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I worked with her years ago, we did a voiceover together, it was a radio ad. And this was how long ago it was, in the voiceover studios you were allowed to smoke.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Oh, gosh.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And so I, I was a smoker, and Joanna came into the booth, and I was sitting there and there's an ashtray in the booth as was customary, and I was really nervous, and I said to her, 'Joanna, would you mind if I smoked?' And she said, [in Joanna Lumley voice] 'Darling, I absolutely insist upon it.'

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And I just smoked the whole way, it was gross.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** [laughing] Oh my God, love it. Love it, feel like she definitely has a good time.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah, yeah.

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: D'you know what I mean, like, she has a nice time.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah, and she makes sure everyone else does. You can feel that about her.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Uh-huh. For sure.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: We are not here to talk about Joan Lumley-

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Oh.

NICK GRIMSHAW: -for the full half hour.

[crew laugh]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Okay.

NICK GRIMSHAW: But we'll come back to her.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Okay.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Every five minutes. I do, Peter, want to talk to you about your food likes and dislikes.

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Oh.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** It was one of the best responses truly we've ever got.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Oh!** 

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** This was quite incredible. So you dictated your likes and dick like- you dictated your likes and dislikes and...

[crew laugh]

NICK GRIMSHAW: Um... first-

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Wrong list.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah, wrong list.

[crew laugh]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Your dick likes is different, yeah. First guest to do this on Dish ever, and you've said it sounds a bit like a stream of consciousness. Your likes: 'Love a breakfast thing. If I could have one meal, a breakfast brunch, like poached eggs, muffin, eggs benedict, amazing bread, like the stuff at The Wolseley, butter, avocado.' Love.

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Love that, just reeling out of you.

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Uh-huh.

NICK GRIMSHAW: I too believe breakfast is the best.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Isn't it, yeah, of course.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** And I go to bed excitedly thinking about breakfast every night.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Really?

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Wow.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Like, 'What'll I have?'

[laughter]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Same thing every day, yeah. And you says, 'I remember having whipped butter at a Denny's outside of San Francisco when I was eighteen, and I wrote a letter home to my parents about it.'

[crew laugh]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, I did, yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** About butter?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** About butter, yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah. It was great.

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** It was, I mean-

NICK GRIMSHAW: Great butter.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** -I thought this was like fine dining, you know. Denny's.

NICK GRIMSHAW: And what is a Denny's? Is a Denny's like a, a diner?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** It's like a sort of a, like a chain diner, that is a bit like a kind of, if Americans had like a Wimpy or something like that, maybe.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Right. Okay. Yeah. I love that you're telling them about that, like, 'Get a load of this.' I remember though, going into Manchester, mid-nineties, and going into this really fab looking, futuristic building and it was all silver inside and looked like New York. And it was a Pret A Manger, right?

[crew laugh]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** But it was the first Pret in Manchester, so I thought it was a standalone, independent store. And I remember like telling family, friends, being like, 'There's this place you can get like a cappuccino.'

[laughter]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** 'And like a sandwich with avocado in it,' and they were like-

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** [in Mancunian accent] 'Cappuccino, what's that? Some kind of dog?'

[laughter]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** And they were like, 'What?' and they were like, 'Pret?' I was like, 'Yeah, [in French accent] Pret A Manger.'

[laughter]

NICK GRIMSHAW: 'It's a French place,' and they were like, 'It's a chain.'

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** You know-

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** So it's quite like your Denny's.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** -I was shooting something in Manchester around that time. I stayed in some big hotel in the centre of Manchester.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Okay.** 

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And I asked the guy on the desk, I said, 'Is there anywhere that you can get some sushi around here?'

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And he said-

NICK GRIMSHAW: 'No.'

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** He said, 'Yeah, yeah, definitely, yeah. You go out the door, turn left, about 200 metres down the road there's a Pret La Manga on the corner.'

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Honestly, that's what he said.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Pret La Manga.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Pret La Manga.

NICK GRIMSHAW: That's really good. Peter's likes and dislikes.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Carries on, 'Love, mashed potato.'

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Oh, yeah, yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** 'And make a good mashed potato with the skin on for texture.'

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Mmm.** 

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** So how do you mash that down easily then?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Just, I'm strong.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** O- [laughs]

[crew laugh]

NICK GRIMSHAW: Very strong. Just with his hands.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ: But-**

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Just mash it like this.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** But I have had some kind of crappy mashers.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Oh yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** That bend.

NICK GRIMSHAW: It's a nightmare, Peter.

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** What would you do in that situation?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Do you have a ricer?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ: No.** 

ANGELA HARTNETT: Okay. Get yourself a ricer.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Okay.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** And, but a whisk would do the job, I reckon.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** A whisk. What about chewing?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Chewi-[laughs]

[laughter]

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Just add a load of butter and eat it, you know. Yeah, that's it, just do it like that. Don't worry.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Do the mashing in there.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah, mash it in your face.

NICK GRIMSHAW: That'll be be good, yeah. 'Love a sandwich.'

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, I love a sandwich, yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Peter says that he, 'went to New York and I was seventeen and they had these subway type style stores called Blimpie. Turkey, swiss cheese, mayonnaise, mustard. That's my sandwich.

ANGELA HARTNETT Yeah, that's good.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Lettuce as well.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Mmm.** 

ANGELA HARTNETT Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: You say that you do find haggis very tasty.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Oh, I love haggis.

ANGELA HARTNETT Yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Love a bit of haggis.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, yeah, yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: And you also love offal. We've never had a-

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I think I do, yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: -offal lover, out and proud on the show.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** [laughs]

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah we have.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Have we? Who?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Emma, Emma Barnett.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Did she? Oh, she loved it.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Wow.** 

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** She loves her offal, yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Your dislikes were amazing. You say, 'There was a movie called Argo, and there's a bit in it that always stuck with me. There's a gangster guy in it, he's a godfather type and he's preparing food and says, 'These tomatoes you get from the supermarket are just crap.' And it stuck with me about tomatoes as they're bland. I remember being in Italy and they're totally

different fruit.' I love this, by the way, as a response to like, 'What food you like?'

NICK GRIMSHAW: We are having pasta today, which is great news-

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Great.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** -because you said, 'Love pasta. F\*\*\*\*\* love it. All of it.'

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** All of it.

[crew laugh]

NICK GRIMSHAW: All of it.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Delicious.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I'd love to be a pasta designer.

NICK GRIMSHAW: [laughing] Mmm.

[crew laugh]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** You could be. And finally you say, 'I'm not fussy, and I wouldn't make a fuss about things like on Come Dine With Me. F\*\*\*\*\* babies.'

[crew laugh]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** They are babies.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Isn't it?

NICK GRIMSHAW: It drives me mad on that.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** And they try it like it's poison.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And they do a thing where they look at the menu and they go, 'What? Salt and caramel?'

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And like looking around at people to validate their, 'Yeah, this is bizarre.'

NICK GRIMSHAW: 'It's crazy.'

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Do love it though.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Come on. I love it, can't start watching it. Love it. Fantastic. It's fantastic.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Do we do this at my house tomorrow night or is it...

[crew laugh]

NICK GRIMSHAW: Uh, yeah, yours tomorrow.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** And then mine on Friday.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Have you got your score cards? Have you got them ready?

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Yeah, we've got the scorecards ready. Do you like cooking Peter?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I do when I do, but I do it kind of seldom and I don't really have many dishes. I mean, I can do some good like sausages and mash, and I do this Jamie Oliver courgette carbonara, I love courgettes.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Oh yeah, yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Mmm.** 

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** With the egg at the end and the pecorino and stuff.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, yeah, yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Peter, when you were little, did you have a favourite dinner that your family would have? We always had potato hash, which I hated as a child.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Oh, we, we had-

NICK GRIMSHAW: Fond memories.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** -corned beef hash, is that the same kind of thing?

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah, yeah, yeah, yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, I loved that.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And that reminds me of, my mum used to make, she would call it Cartoon Tea, because we called dinner tea up north, right?

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** So I, I'm from Liverpool and, Cartoon Tea, which was Desperate Dan from the Dandy.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I remember he had a, he had a big pile of mashed potatoes.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm. And he had the sausages-

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Sausages.

NICK GRIMSHAW: -sort of stuck out.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Stuck in, yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** So my mum would do that.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Would do that.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Oh, I love that.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** And then now, like when you are saying, gonna have one of your dinner parties, which you are next week.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Mm-hm.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** What would you do? What's your like dish that you're most proud of your, one that you could really be like, I know it's good.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I think out of all the, the one dish that I know, it would probably have to be that one dish.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mmm, that one.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah. The carbonara pasta.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yes. Actually, I think I'd probably learn a new dish.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Uh-huh.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** But not do that thing that people do on Come Dine With Me where they've never cooked and they attempt something-

NICK GRIMSHAW: Quite ridiculous, yeah

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** -very, very tricky, you know, like that Japanese fish that's poisonous unless you prepare it in a certain way or...

NICK GRIMSHAW: 'Thought I'd just try it.'

## [laughter]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** 'Thought I'd just try it today and see what happens.' Do you remember when you moved to London, did you enter a new food universe at all? Because my mum and dad had me in their forties, so I was born in the eighties, they were born in the forties, so their-

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Wow.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** -they liked their, you know, traditional food, like roast dinner, potato hash, like meat and vegetables.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** So then when I'd gone to London, I was trying stuff that I'd never had in my life before, like a sweet potato.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Or like, avocado. Do you remember that happening when you moved to London?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I do, yeah. There was a place called Falafel King, I remember having falafels, and thinking they were very exotic.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Yes.** 

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I love them still.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Hummus. And then recently, I was in Brooklyn. My friend took me to this restaurant, I ordered the quinoa salad.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Oh, right, right.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** But it's pronounced quinoa.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Right.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** As they, as everybody told me.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Uh-huh.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, and I, I was just very embarrassed.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah, th- we didn't have quinoa up north.

[cutlery sounds]

NICK GRIMSHAW: Right, the food has arrived.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Food has arrived.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: It-**

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** So we have a BLT pasta.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** BLT pasta.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Cause we know you like sort of breakfast-y stuff, we know you like pasta, so we've basically done a spicy tomato sauce-

NICK GRIMSHAW: [gasps] Ooh.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** With loads of pancetta in there as well-

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Oooh.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** -because you love pancetta.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, yeah, yeah, yeah.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Finished with a touch of rocket and some parmesan on top.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Oh, fantastic.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** And we-

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Look at this.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** -and if you were drinking some wine at home, you'd have some Jip Jip Rocks Shiraz from Australia.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm. Mmm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Ooh. That's won a lot of awards, as well.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah, loads.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** So bon appétit.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Wow.** 

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Wonderful.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Wow. Ange, wow that is spicy.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** It is, it is a bit too spicy.

NICK GRIMSHAW: No I like it. I love a spicy pasta. Can we just-

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** [makes growling sound]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** -say as well, when Ange made the sauce...

[crew laugh]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** [makes growling sound]

NICK GRIMSHAW: [makes growling sound]

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** [makes growling sound]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** [makes growling sound] When Ange made the sauce, she tried it, and then you'd arrived and the sauce was done, and Ange just tried the sauce and went, 'Just have a quick check if he's okay with spicy foods.'

[laughter]

NICK GRIMSHAW: We were like, it's made! It's made. It's already made.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah. it was like, too late.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Mmm.** 

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Mmm, it's great.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** That is good.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** You happy?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** This is great.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Mmm.** 

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** That's good.

NICK GRIMSHAW: That is good. So, Ange, you made this from scratch.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Scratch, yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** What's, what is step one to make this BLT pasta?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Step one, chop some onion and garlic into a pan with some olive oil

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** And chilli, and then cook that for about ten minutes till nice and soft.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Add your tinned tomatoes.

NICK GRIMSHAW: I have a garlic question.

**ANGELA HARTNETT: Yes.** 

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** I thought when you added garlic, you added a bit later so you don't burn it, or you just add more oil.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** I've just added more oil.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Okay.** 

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah, I had enough oil in there, and I was stirring it, so yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Okay, keep it-

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah, yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Okay, good.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** But if you don't want to, you can add it later.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Okay.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Then add your toma- tinned tomatoes.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Rinse out your tin with a touch of water, so you get all the tomatoes in there, and then cook it for about forty-five minutes.

NICK GRIMSHAW: And that is it?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** And then on the side, cook off your pancetta, just while your pasta's cooking, and then add that into the pasta with the tomato sauce and finish with rocket.

NICK GRIMSHAW: And chilli.

ANGELA HARTNETT: And chilli. Lots of chili.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mmm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Mmm. Angela, it's, it's really, really good.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Mmm.** 

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Oh, thank you.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** It's really good.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** This is very good, Ange.

**ANGELA HARTNETT: Mm.** 

NICK GRIMSHAW: Really is. And you've added pancetta.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Mm.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Love a bit of pancetta. Why does it work so well, rather than say, bacon?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Well, it's slightly more cured, and there's a lot of fat on it.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** From where they sort of take it, so you get all the fatty flavours as much as you get the meat part of it, and the fat renders down. It's like, that's why the carbonara, a great carbonara is all pancetta or guanciale, 'cause it's all the pork cheek.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** So that's what make, makes this good.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** So where's pancetta from on a pig?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Pancetta is basically the ribs.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Mm-hm.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** That's where it is. It's where the bacon is. But it's how they make it with the different spices, and they cure it more.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm. And what about if you don't fancy pancetta?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** You could do it with bacon.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.** 

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** But our guest likes pancetta.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yes, we do need the pancetta.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** That's why we've done it, for Peter.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Did you ever see-

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, I would've freaked out.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** He would've freaked out if I'd put a bit of back bacon in there.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Do you hate when people ask-

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** [laughs]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** -you know, do you hate it when people ask for substitutes?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** No. What? At home or in the restaurant?

[crew laugh]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Just like generally. Do you remember that famous Nigel Slater tweet?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** No, what did he do?

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** When Nigel Slater put up a recipe and it was like a baba ganoush blah-di-blah with lemon and parsley, and someone replied being like, 'Oh, well what if you don't like aubergine?'

ANGELA HARTNETT: Oh God.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** And Nigel Slater replied to her, she was called like Jeanine, and he replied like, 'Jeanine, it's an aubergine recipe.'

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Mm.

NICK GRIMSHAW: [laughing] Full stop.

[laughter]

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Nigel weren't having it.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Was it, was the person's name, Jean? Aubergine.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Aubergine!

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Aubergine.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** If you wanna try this recipe or any, we do on Dish, waitrose.com/dishrecipes. All the recipes are on there, all the ingredients, how to do it. We filmed a video as well.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yep.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Sounds easy. But if you wanna watch the video, watch it.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** It's there?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I'm gonna to do this.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I'm gonna do this.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** You are?

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Ooh yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** It's great, and it's like-

ANGELA HARTNETT: Send us a picture when you do it.

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Yeah, okay.

NICK GRIMSHAW: We'll be there.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Um-**

[crew laugh]

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Oh we're there, yeah, we're coming over [laughs].

NICK GRIMSHAW: We'll be there. And do you think it's best to use penne?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Rigatoni, yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Rigatoni, sorry.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah, you can, or you can do spaghetti.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** That's why I'd like to be a pasta designer because like I, I just wonder...

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** What's next?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah because some pastas like, stick to the sauce more and stuff, you know, but like, I don't know.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** What pasta would you design? Have you thought about it?

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Yeah, Möbius-

ANGELA HARTNETT: Oh.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Möbius strip spaghetti.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Mmm.** 

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** [laughs]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Like infinite, it's like where you get a strip of spaghetti-

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** -but you do a twist in it and then join it, and then it's technically only has one side.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Oh.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Ooh yeah.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Okay.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** So you can eat it forever.

NICK GRIMSHAW: It just keeps going. Infinity pasta.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** [laughs]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, yeah, yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, you put on a lot of weight though.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah, yeah, yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: I like it. I'm down.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

[drink pouring sounds]

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Peter?** 

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Mm.** 

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** We need to talk about your new TV show please, because you have a brilliant new Netflix show called Million Dollar Secret.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** It's a show, I guess it's a bit like the Traitors? It's a game show where there's this hotel and I am the maître d' of this hotel.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Mm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And twelve guests arrive at the hotel. And in each of their rooms is a wooden box, and in one of those boxes is a million dollars in cash, and they're there for two weeks, and they have to keep that a secret from the other people. Basically the, the one at the end of the two weeks who has the cash goes home with it.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Right.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And they have to kind of lie to each other, it's all that kind of subterfuge stuff.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm.** 

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And, I've never really done anything like that before.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Mm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** It was-

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Where did you film it?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** In Canada. It was so much fun to do this thing.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** It was [laughing] really good fun.

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And it was quite food-y as well 'cause like, at the end of each day we had an elimination dinner.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Right.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And I'm sat at the head of this table and then there's all the, all the people in the show, and they're basically just kind of arguing between each other who, who they suspect.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** So have they done challenges or anything-

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Yeah, yeah.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** -so- see, to get the money?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** So they do challenges to get a clue-

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Oh, I see.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** -about the person-

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Okay, right.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** -who is the current millionaire.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Okay.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Uh-huh

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: And-

NICK GRIMSHAW: That's good.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** -what a thing, to sit there and just eat this amazing food and then just occasionally chip in to just kind of stir up s\*\*\*-

NICK GRIMSHAW: Stir it up.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Stir the pot [*laughs*]

NICK GRIMSHAW: And do you know who has the box?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, I do, and...

NICK GRIMSHAW: And do the viewers know? Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** The viewers know.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And it was great doing this in real time. They would have breakfast, and I would go in and tell them about some kind of thing about the millionaire. I'd say to them, 'The millionaire's got a challenge to do, so be on the lookout for any odd behaviour,' right.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And then I would leave them. And then I'd go up to my dressing room, and then I would see them all, all talking about me and saying, [in American accent] 'Well, did you hear what Peter said about the-'

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** 'Because the way he looked at you, I thought that maybe you had some kind of information or...'.

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** You know, and that was so exciting.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah, yeah, yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I loved it, and I'm gonna be there when someone's gonna win a million dollars.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Mm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And then two other people instantly, they know they've lost a million dollars.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Oof.** 

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And like, the emotion of that?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah, course, yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** You know, it's like...

NICK GRIMSHAW: It's big.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** It's really good [laughs]

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** [laughs]

NICK GRIMSHAW: Oh good-

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Really good, yeah, yeah, yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: I like the sound of this.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Okay, good.

NICK GRIMSHAW: I love when you were saying about them having the theories. Cause I love on Traitors, when you see like a group just go off on-

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** -nothing.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Their little chats.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** And they just go off and they're like, 'Well, the way that her trousers were'-

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** [laughs]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** -and I'm just like, what? And they like fully convin- and people are like, 'Yeah, yeah, yeah.'

[laughter]

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Right.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** 'Did you see that?'

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** It's just quite interesting seeing human behaviour at work, isn't it?

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah, exactly.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, I haven't seen it, I, I didn't watch it 'cause I didn't want to be influenced by it-

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** -you know?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah, okay, makes sense, yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** So you don't wanna be doing a Claudia Winkleman impression?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** No.

[laughs]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** No. No.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Not again.

[dinner table sounds]

NICK GRIMSHAW: We have mentioned Amandaland.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yes.

NICK GRIMSHAW: You've mentioned Amandaland, because you are brilliant in it-

NICK GRIMSHAW: Episode four, is where he enters.

[applause]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Stop it.

[applause]

NICK GRIMSHAW: It's a wow.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Stop it.

[applause]

NICK GRIMSHAW: It's a wow. It's a wow-

ANGELA HARTNETT: You changed the show. Changed it.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** I feel like there's gonna be an Amandaland spinoff, Johannesland.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah [laughs]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Johannesburg.

**ANGELA & NICK:** Johannesburg!

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: I love that show so much. I thought it was so fantastic-

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: -and I love you in it, truly.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Lucy Punch is just hilarious.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah she is.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Oh my God.

NICK GRIMSHAW: It feels like you enjoyed that.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Mm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Oh, I really did. It was like one of the most enjoyable jobs I've ever done. Yeah, I loved it.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm. You can tell.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah, you could see it.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** I could tell, it was so f\*\*\*\*\* funny though.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** But everyone says they enjoy each other's company.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** They're just having a great time on the set. As much as they are doing the whole production of it.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** That's what you get the impression.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah. And you know, sometimes that that doesn't equate to a good show.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Sure.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** You know, if you have fun and think, oh wowand you're playing to the crew, you know, and you kind of, and you think, wow, that was really cool and everyone laughed and blah, blah blah, and then it just doesn't fit in, you know? So I've made a- that mistake a few times.

[laughter]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Your sister?

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Yeah. Helen.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Writes on this?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Yeah, yeah, yeah, yeah, yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Helly, she created Motherland, that was her idea.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Oh, fab.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And she was writing on Motherland, so I would turn up, and my sister's there and you know, it was great, we were just hanging out, me and my sis, it was-

NICK GRIMSHAW: Oh, that's nice.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Nice.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** So it was so lovely. Oh, also just, talking about my family, my, my mum said to say that she's a big fan of both of you.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Oh, bless.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And she used to work in Surrey on the tills in Waitrose, and she went to the Waitrose dinner, where the, like the boss of Waitrose is, and the boss of Waitrose sat next to her.

NICK GRIMSHAW: [gasps]

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Oh my God.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I mean, I dunno whether she's lying about that-

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** But, I mean, we've never actually seen her in Waitrose.

[laughter]

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Wear a uniform.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** But anyway, yeah, she, she wanted me to say that, and she asked if I could ask you to send her a sandwich. Would that be okay?

[laughter]

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** That's what she said.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Of course, anytime.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Great.

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah, course. Let's do it.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah. What we gonna send her?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** You know your sandwich, who I think you would like is Keeley Hawes.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Keeley Hawes, mm.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Cream cheese.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** On white bread, old school white bread.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Okay.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** It was delicious.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Really?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** I pimp it up with a few crisps.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Mmm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Thank you.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Bless her.

[drink pouring sounds]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Shall we do the fast food quiz with Peter Serafinowicz?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yes.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Let's do it.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Thank you so much for pronouncing my surname, correct.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yes.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Is that correct? Okay.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I had this sketch show on BBC2, 2007 it was.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** And it was called the Peter Serafinowicz Show.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mm-hm.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** You don't hear that surname often. But-

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: No. I do.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** -yeah, you do obviously.

[laughter]

[crew laughs]

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Quite often-

[laughter]

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** -I don't! Surprisingly enough.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** I spell it often.

[laughter]

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** So Peter, all we need is your favourite way to eat the following.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yes. Tell us your favourite way to eat eggs.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** With my mouth.

[laughter]

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yes, correct.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Very good.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Favourite form of potato?

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** There are ones that come out like in the spring called Golden something, that are from...

NICK GRIMSHAW: Oh, Golden something?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yukon?

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Yeah, yeah, Yukon, like in like the g-

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah, the American ones, yeah.

PETER SERAFINOWICZ: Oh, no.

NICK GRIMSHAW: [bangs table] Pass!

[laughter]

[makes buzzer sound]

ANGELA HARTNETT: But mash, your favourite for- to eat-

**NICK GRIMSHAW: Mash!** 

ANGELA HARTNETT: Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** Skin on mash.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Mash. Skin on mash.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Skin on mash. There we go.

**NICK GRIMSHAW:** Peter, what is your favourite crisp?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Yeah.

**PETER SERAFINOWICZ:** It's kind of boring but Tyrell's Lightly Salted?

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** Okay, yeah.

NICK GRIMSHAW: Yeah.

**ANGELA HARTNETT:** We'll, we'll let that.

[applause]
